NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

FILING OF SEALED BIDS

Sealed Bids will be received by the City Secretary of the City of Eagle Lake ("Owner"), at Office of City Secretary, 100 East Main, Eagle Lake, TX 77434 until **2:00 PM on Thursday, June 9, 2022**, for the construction of the proposed Wastewater Collection System Improvements for said Owner, as described in the Specifications and drawings therefore on file in the office of the City Secretary of the City of Eagle Lake. Bids will be publicly opened, read, and tabulated on the day and hour specified above, and will be acted upon by the Owner at that time or at such later time and place as the Owner may then determine.

GENERAL PROJECT DESCRIPTION

All Work, materials, and equipment are to be in accordance with the Contract Documents on file in the office of the City Secretary and at www.CivCastUSA.com by this reference made a part hereof as though fully set out and incorporated herein.

The Work for the said improvement, as required by the Contract Documents, is generally described as follows:

Furnish and install all labor, materials, and equipment for the replacement and rehabilitation to the City's sanitary sewer collection system. Remove existing 4-inch, 6-inch, and 8-inch sanitary sewer line and replace with 8-inch sanitary sewer line including new manholes and service connections as shown in the drawings. All improvements including sitework, restoration and seeding, and pavement repairs, together with related subsidiary and incidental work in accordance with the plans and specifications.

The City of Eagle Lake, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Work under the proposed Contract Documents shall be commenced upon written Notice to Proceed and shall be completed and ready for operation on or before 180 calendar days, subject to any extension of time, which may be granted by the Owner.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION

Each Bid shall be made on the Bid Form prepared for this purpose, which may be obtained from the Engineer. Any alteration in the official Bid Form will entitle the Owner, at its option, to reject the Bid from consideration. Each Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond or a certified cashier's check, drawn on a solvent state or national bank, or a certified share draft drawn on a credit union in Texas or chartered under the laws of the United States, and filed in a sealed envelope separate from the one containing the Bid. The Bid Bond shall be substantially in the form set forth in the Contract Documents. The Contractor's certified check or Bid Bond shall be in an amount equal to five (5) percent of the amount of the Bid, made payable to the Owner. The check may be cashed for the full amount by the Owner or the Bid Bond forfeited in the full amount to the Owner as liquidated damages in the event the successful Bidder fails to enter into contract and file acceptable bonds satisfactory to the Owner assuring the faithful fulfillment of the contract and maintenance of said improvements as required by law within ten (10) days after the acceptance of the Bid.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to readvertise for Bids or to defer action on the Bids received for a period not to exceed 45 days from and after the date and time specified in this Notice to Bidders for receiving said Bids, and to waive irregularities and informalities.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance and Warranty Bond and a Payment Bond, each in an amount equal to one hundred (100) percent of the contract price. Said bonds to be issued by a responsible Surety approved by the Owner and shall guarantee that the Principal shall promptly make payment to all persons, firms, Subcontractors, and corporations furnishing materials for or performing labor in the performance of the Work stated and the faithful performance of the contract and the terms and conditions therein contained and the guarantee and maintenance of said facilities in good repair and working conditions for not less than one (1) year(s) from the Notice of Acceptability of such improvements by the Owner.

Payment of the cost of said project will be made from TxCDBG funds as received (Owner to Pay when Paid).

Awarded Contractor and sub-contractors are required to be cleared by the Federal Government's System of Award Management (SAM) prior to award.

By virtue of statutory authority, preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Texas, and to Texas domestic labor, to the extent lawfully required under Texas statutes provided that the award of contract will be made to the lowest responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid, which shall be determined without regard to state or local laws whereby preference is given on factors other than the amount of the Bid.


