ABOUT THE CITY OF EAGLE LAKE:

Eagle Lake is a city in southeastern Colorado County in Texas. The population was 3,639 at the 2010 Census. The City is home to a golf course, the largest private lake in Texas, and the Eagle Lake Regional Airport, which serves light aircraft. The lake, along with adjacent rice fields, attracts a large variety of migratory birds. The city is known as the "Goose-hunting Capital of the World." The City is home to the Attwater's Prairie Chicken National Wildlife Refuge, a sanctuary for an endangered species. The Colorado River is nearby with access points to boating, kayaking and fishing. The City has many buildings and homes on the historic designation list. City Hall is also located within Historic Downtown. Eagle Lake is just 66 miles west of Houston.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Works under the administrative direction of the City Administrator and accountable to the City Council as a municipal officer; responsible for the management of all operations of the Police Department including law enforcement, crime prevention, investigations, training and community relations and responsible management of the departmental budget; work requires the directing of personnel in the effective performance of keeping the peace, the protection of life and property, prevention of crime, apprehension of criminals, and the enforcement of all applicable city, state, and federal laws and ordinances; and performs other related duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS / REQUIREMENTS:

High School Graduate or GED; current Texas Driver's License, and a Master Peace Officer certification from TCLEOSE is required. Prefer applicant to have achieved an Associate's or Bachelor's college degree in criminal justice, public or business administration, or related field from an accredited college or university. Prefer a minimum of ten (10) years' experience in law enforcement work including at least five (5) years in a supervisory level of law enforcement management.

SALARY: \$58,000 to \$64,000 annually D.O.Q., along with excellent city-provided benefits. Employees are also vested after five years.
