## **CHIEF OPERATOR I**

### **DESCRIPTION:**

Perform semi-skilled and skilled work of average difficulty in the maintenance and operations of wastewater plant and pumping facilities. Perform related work as required.

### **JOB REQUIREMENTS:**

- Monitor lift stations and plants for proper operation
- Check water tank levels
- Make daily and monthly reports on water and wastewater operations
- Take water and wastewater samples for testing
- Change chlorine bottles
- Service and repair pumps, chlorinators and other equipment
- Replace valves and lines around pump stations and plants
- Compile and prepare monthly reports for regulatory agencies
- Train employees on monitoring and operational procedures
- Discuss work assignments with supervisor, but is usually free to decide how to do work
- Submit and file all necessary TCEQ paperwork in compliance with regulations

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Have a valid Texas class "C" Driver's License
- Minimum TCEQ issued Class "C" Water/Wastewater license with two years-experience
